

VoIP Telephone Service

(Voice over Internet Protocol)

Description

Telephone service via an adapter connected to your Internet connection and regular telephone plugs into adapter.

(Computer does <u>not</u> have to be left on for VOIP to work.)

Monthly Costs

VOIP service - \$27.50 (monthly) (no tax except for WI residents) (VOIP's '214' number is a local number.) {VOIP number is not included in phone book.}

Initial Costs

VOIP unit - \$64.95 + tax (one-time payment)

Customer has option to keep '265' phone number. ['800' numbers can also be ported.] \$20.00 one-time fee for each ported number.

- Customer must provide copy of most recent phone bill to Fast-Air.
- Current phone company (ex. AT&T) takes about 1 to 2 weeks to port current phone number over.

Number listed in the phone book (one-time fee of \$15.00)

This means that customer could have 2 phone bills for one month until process is complete.}

VOIP Service: Caller ID

Voicemail (can be disabled to be Answering Machine compatible)

{Messages can be emailed or viewed online.}

Call Waiting Call Forwarding

Unlimited local & long distance

911

If for some reason, a customer decides to cancel VOIP service, they must <u>first</u> contact their previous phone company to do the switch-over or they will lose their '265' number.

Fast-Air Internet provides a test unit to its customers so they can try the VOIP Service for 1 week to see if they would like to go ahead and subscribe to the service.
